Special Education Issues

- Schools refusing to provide special education assessments/ IEP denials
- Schools not responding to requests for Special education services
- IEP implementation issues (services not being provided, need more services)
- Schools not conducting annual IEP meetings or within 30 days of caregiver requesting one
- Schools not conducting triennial assessments (these are in-depth assessments that should happen every three years to see if the youth's needs have changed)

School Discipline Defense

- Student told not to return to school/informal suspension
- Student recommended for expulsion
- Opportunity Transfer appeals/student being told they need to change schools

Education Access

- School closure due to fire damage
- Enrollment in a new school or district
- Disenrollment
- Discrimination
